Galia Chimiak, dr hab., is an associate professor at the Institute of Philosophy and Sociology of the Polish Academy of Sciences. Her research focuses on NGOs, civil society, and international development cooperation. In 2024–25 she was a Fulbright Senior Awardee in USA. She has worked with UNDP in Bosnia and Herzegovina, lectured at universities in Poland, Ireland and USA, and since 2022 has served as co-editor-in-chief of VOLUNTAS: International Journal of Voluntary and Nonprofit Organizations. She is also an active member of the Polish Sociological Association and the International Society for Third-Sector Research.
